

CTS Invited to Address Digital Health and Telemedicine Summit

PERTH, [21/11/2020] – **Caretech Services** (CTS), WA-based intelligent packaging developer, today announced it had accepted an invitation to address the IDHC [Digital Health and Telemedicine Summit](#) at the University of Western Australia on Friday December 4th 2020.

CTS will be presenting “The Case for Intelligent Procedural Packaging”, with a focus on COVID vaccine distribution, on which CTS has been working with stakeholders in both the US and India.

The Indo-Asia Digital Health Centre for Innovation and Commercialisation (IDHC) is a not-for-profit entity, committed to improving the quality and accessibility of healthcare and health systems using digital health and telemedicine solutions.

“We were delighted to accept the IHDC’s invitation to address the Digital Health and Telemedicine Summit” said Gregg Boalch, Managing Director, CTS.

“It will not only give us the opportunity to present the case for intelligent procedural packaging, but also to apply it to the issues discussed during the Summit. We feel the SIP System has much to offer in the 2 focus areas of the Summit – indigenous health and COVID” he said.

CTS are working with a number of global technology and packaging partners to run field trials of the SIP System in Australia, India and the US.

The SIP System comprises medication-specific procedural packaging with smarts.

The packaging enables everything required to provide a specific procedure (e.g. medication, vaccination) is contained in the one pack – no more running around getting the necessary vials, syringes, swabs etc.

The smarts enable counterfeit detection, prescription validation and contraindication checks with other medications on the patient’s medical record before the treatment is provided, and the automatic update of patient and stock control records once the treatment has been provided - all from a Smartphone. The smarts also provide public health authorities and medical regulators with deidentified data for their mandated disease management and medication monitoring purposes respectively.
